

## TRANS ATLANTIC AIR COMPETITION DELIVERS CHEAP FARES TO TRAVELERS

ROUNDTRIP flights to Europe are on offer for less than \$500 – including taxes and surcharges – as airlines battle for a larger share of the Trans Atlantic travel dollar.

Liberty Travel air contracting and distribution vice president John Beauvais said keen competition on the East Coast USA-Europe route meant that travelers could now take advantage of some of the hottest airfare deals in recent memory.

He said roundtrip fares from New York to major European cities were available for a fraction of their historical price, as traditional carriers took on their low cost rivals.

“This all adds up to major savings for travelers,” Mr Beauvais said.

“At the same time, and given the relatively short flying time between New York and Europe, it also opens up the Continent as a highly affordable vacation alternative for short breaks or longer getaways.

“American Airlines, Iberia and British Airways are just some of the airlines that have eye catching special deals on offer at the moment.

“As is always the case, it is impossible to predict how long these special deals will last.

“Generally, fares have reverted to more sustainable levels after periods of heavy discounting, so it is certainly worth considering the options that are currently available.”

The American Airlines fares are currently on sale until February 6 and allow travelers to take off to Europe between now and April 2.
